Final Instructions

These final instructions are supplementary to the National Sporting Code of the ACU, the Enduro Standing Regulations, The Long Course Timecard Regulations, the BEC Sidecar and Classic Championship Conditions, and the event Supplementary Regulations.

Paddock Location: Cilgawod Farm, Caio, Carmarthenshire

Sat Nav: Use postcode **SA19 8PG** and follow the arrows.

Parking

- Please park as instructed.

Camping

- Available at Cilgawod from 3pm Friday 15th May.
- All generators off by 10:30pm
- Generators must be placed on an environmental mat
- Dogs are allowed at Cilgawod which is a working farm but must always be kept on their leads. Please dispose of any dog poo bags.

Event Facilities

- There are Toilets onsite, Ladies only clearly stated on the doors. However, there is NO drinking water available.
- There will be a Catering Unit at the venue

Signing-On/ Machine Examination – Saturday 16th May

- Time: **8am-9:30am**
- Spot checks will be undertaken on ACU Licenses. Make sure your ACU License is downloaded onto your phone & that your photograph is visible.
- **Printed backgrounds/numbers provided.**
- Bikes must comply to Enduro Standing Regulations.
- Bikes must have front light fitted. Checks will NOT be made to see whether they work.
- **Enduro Tyres** complying with current FIM/ACU Enduro regulations must be used.
- **Noise Control** – noise checks **will be undertaken** at Machine Examination.



- **ACU-approved helmet** mandatory. Approved Chest guards recommended.
 - **NEW FOR 2026 – Front Sprocket Guards must be fitted at all times.**

Route Information

- Approx. **27miles per lap**
 - There will be 1 Special Tests per lap
 - The number of laps will depend on class & weather conditions.
 - The route will run in the same direction both days and use orange arrows.
 - First riders will start at 10am.
 - Start order will be shared before and displayed on the day.
 - There is no Parc Ferme or Work Area, Riders are required to present your machine at the start **5 minutes before their start time**
 - Start line procedure is dead engine start as per ACU Standing Regs.

Special Tests

Open for viewing from **4pm, Friday 15th May.**

- The will be **timed each lap after a sighting visit at the start of lap 1**
 - Viewing the Special Tests by any form of bicycle is prohibited.
-

Refuelling

- Refuelling is **ONLY** permitted within the designated Refuelling/Service Areas.
 - **Environmental mats** required for **refuelling/servicing.**
 - Smoking is strictly forbidden in the refuelling areas.

Blue Tape Areas

- These will be marked with blue tape & riders **must not exceed walking pace** – penalty up to disqualification.
-

Course Cutting

- **ANY RIDERS CAUGHT COURSE CUTTING WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
 - If a rider leaves the special test track (through tapes), they **must re-enter at the same spot if safe to do so.** Failure may result in **up to a 5-minute penalty**
 - The route crosses through farmland where the route will be marked with gated arrows, please stay between the gated arrows, and don't ride across fields.

Maximum Late Allowance

- 30 minutes in championship and expert, 60 minutes all other classes.

Retirement/Accidents

- If you retire, you must ensure that your timecard is handed in immediately at the time control to enable the club to account for all riders at the conclusion of each day.
 - Any accidents must be reported to the Event Secretary ASAP at event admin.

Hard Standing Paddock

- Strictly NO pressure washing.
- No mud scrapings to be left on the hard standing paddock. Please dispose onto the grass areas.
